## IT'S THAT PLAN AGAIN !

After several months in the long grass, the Expansion Strategy promoted by the West Northamptonshire Joint Planning Unit (WNJPU), has resurfaced for a new round of consultation.

The Strategy backed by Northampton, Daventry and South Northants Councils, calls for 40,000 new houses on mainly Greenfield sites around the edges of Northampton.

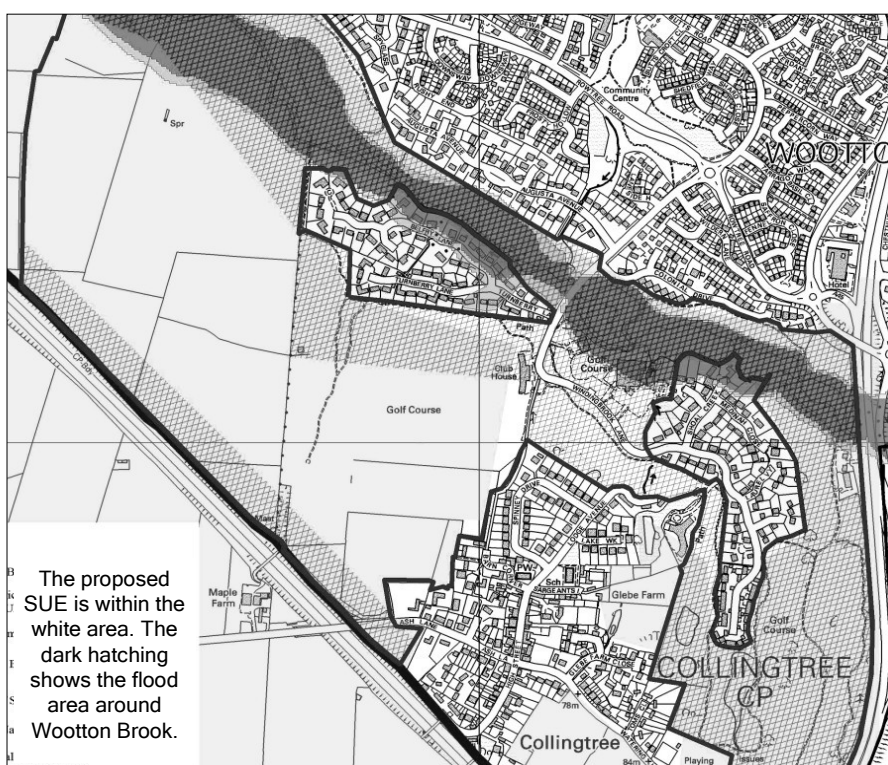
These areas are known as Sustainable Urban Extensions and SUE No.5, on land between Collingtree and East Hunsbury, is allocated for 1,000 houses and related development. This is in line with an earlier proposal by Bovis for new housing on farmland adjoining Collingtree Park Golf Course.

The number of houses in the Collingtree parish has doubled in the last 20 years.

During the last consultation stage in February 2011, the Hunsbury and Collingtree Residents Alliance (HCRA) raised concerns over flood risk at Wootton Brook, traffic congestion along Rowtree Road and the impact on the A45 and Junction 15.

For these reasons the HCRA called for the site to be withdrawn from the Expansion Strategy.

A further 189 representations were made on the SUE No.5 site of which 185 were negative.



Much of the concern was over the lack of infrastructure and questions about where the funding would come from to overcome the traffic and environmental problems.

However, despite these objections, SUE No.5 remains part of the expansion strategy and yet another consultation period runs from July 31st until September 23rd.

After that the Strategy will be passed to the Government and a Public Inquiry is expected in early 2013

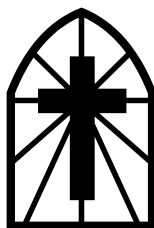

## News Flash .....News Flash ...

It has emerged that a proposal is being actively considered by the County Council to tarmac over the whole of the land bounded by the Hilton Hotel, Watering Lane and High Street South and make it a Park & Ride facility for Silverstone Race Days. The land is owned by the County Council.

The only land excluded would be the Allotments and Cemetery.

No further details are yet available but a plan has been drawn up showing a new entrance off Watering Lane.

Additional uses for the surfaced area are said to include a Lorry Park and /or accommodation for Travellers.

The Parish Council will obviously be investigating this startling proposal together with local County and Borough Councillors.

Watch this space.

## NEW HOPE FOR VILLAGE SPEED LIMITS

Back in 2001, the Parish Council, as part of the development of Glebe Farm Close, argued for a 20mph limit along the whole of Watering Lane and Ash Lane as this only route through the village, is a residential area. In the event the speed restriction was only applied to Watering Lane on cost grounds and meanwhile through traffic has greatly increased.

New guidelines issued to local councils, will give greater freedom to bring in 20mph schemes to improve road safety. The Department of Transport says it is giving traffic authorities more flexibility and reducing the need for costly signage and ineffective road humps.

Under the new guidance, councils will be encouraged to expand 20mph zones and limits where it can be shown they benefit safety and quality of life.
